

Veterans Treatment Court Mentor Coordinator

The Veterans Mentor Coordinator is essential in maintaining the success of the Douglas County Veterans Treatment Court Mentor Program. The Mentor Coordinator is responsible for recruiting prospective mentors, screening candidates, selecting Veteran Mentors, and educating them about the Veterans Treatment Court Program. The Mentor Coordinator will also be responsible for individual and group supervision as well as scheduling mentors to be present during the Court's proceedings. The Mentor Coordinator will coordinate all activities with the VTC Team, VTC Coordinator, and the Judge.

Veterans Treatment Court Mentor Coordinator Duties and Responsibilities

- ✦ Recruit and train volunteer Veterans Treatment Court Mentors.
- ✦ Assist in the retention of Veteran Mentors.
- ✦ Organize and conduct training for Veteran Mentors.
- ✦ Assist in supervision of Veteran Mentors.
- ✦ Assist in developing specialized training projects.
- ✦ Perform duties as assigned by the Judge and Treatment Court Administrator.
- ✦ Sustain and evolve the Veterans Treatment Court Mentor Program.
